
A Note on The Passing of Peter Cameron:



Peter Cameron has passed away on September 5th, 2019 at the age of 90. Peter has been a prominent member of the horse community in North America for 60 years. He has been inducted into the Arabian Horse Association Judges Hall of Fame, the Ontario Quarter Horse Hall of Fame, the Arabian Horse Association of Southern California Hall of Fame, and the Can-Am Equine Emporium Walk of Fame.

He was awarded many awards including: Lifetime Achievement Award from the Arabian Professional & Amateur Horse Association and inducted into their Hall of Fame. He received a Life Membership from The Western Horse Association, an

Honourary Life Membership from the Arabian Horse Association of Eastern Canada and a "People Make A Difference" Award from the Ontario Equestrian Federation. In 2019, at the end of his




